Valentines chocolates to the elderly in the community – although we were in a lockdown we still helped spread some love to the elderly members of our community by delivering some chocolates.


Uber Kindness awards – after Hundreds off applications from across Northern Ireland an independent panel shortlisted 4 of our boys for either a highly commented or winners award.
